The NCDOT added pavement markings and stop signs at the Old Tar Road and Vernon White Road intersection. Drivers are urged to slow down and be cautious of the new traffic pattern. An all-way stop is an effective and cost-efficient way to improve the safety of an intersection and reduce the risk of serious crashes


Safe Routes to School

Temporary intersection changes have arrived at Main St/Church St, Cooper St/Church St, and Cooper St/ Academy St! We're testing out a new street design using curb extensions and high-visibility crosswalks to make these areas safer for kids and community members to cross the road. HOUR AND PLACEMENT FOR GARBAGE AND RECYCLING CANS.

Garbage and recycle containers shall be behind the curb or off the street surface the night before your scheduled service day. Place containers 3 feet apart and at least 10 feet away from: mailboxes; vehicles; streetlights; and electrical poles to prevent damage to the property. The container must face the street with the handles and wheels facing your home.

<u>Piano Lessons</u>

As you develop your hand posture and finger numbers, you will start playing simple melodies, which will introduce you to basic rhythms and timing. We will also explore foundational music theory, learning about the treble and bass clefs, as well as simple note reading. As you progress, you'll start practicing basic scales like C major and G major, and begin incorporating simple chords into your playing, such as C, G, and F major chords. Throughout the month, you'll develop finger strength and independence, experiment with dynamics and varying rhythms, and even work on playing songs with both hands together. By the end of the 30 days, you will have a foundational understanding of piano playing.

The Class 2 Rating is a significant accomplishment and speaks highly of the time and effort contributed by the members of the Fire-Rescue-EMS Department and the Town's commitment to continually improve fire protection. PPC Ratings are quantified as Classes 1-10, with Class 1 being the best. There are 1513 rated fire districts in North Carolina.
