



Golden Age Senior Drop-In Program



- Through these partnerships, we will strengthen our relationships between our neighbors and neighborhoods.


Members can sign up themselves or by family filling out an application. The application is available at the Winterville Police Department.

- Once the application is received by the Police Department and approved, it is entered into our database and a schedule would be setup for the senior. As a part of the application process, a police official would meet with the senior for introductions.
